40:1 - "Comfort" — A sigh of relief

1. God's Eminence (40:3-5)

- Psa. 45:6
- Isa. 6:1-4
- 1 Tim. 1:17

2. God's Permanence (40:6-8)

- Psa. 90:1-2
- Heb. 1:10-12
- He is the majestic One of all time.

3. God's benevolence (40:9-11)

- Isa. 53:6 — Psa. 23:1 — Heb. 13:20
- Psa. 23 —

- Because "the Lord is my Shepherd..."

1. David is CONTENT.

2. David is COURAGEOUS.

3. David is CONFIDENT.

- "The Lord..." (23:1) "... the Lord forever" (23:6)

4. God's Omnipotence (40:12-14)

- Series of rhetorical questions
- These things prove God's omnipotence:
 - Seas — He has it all in the palm of His hand.
 - Space — He measured all of the galaxies in a span!

- Sands - God took 3 fingers like a pitch fork,
Scooped up the sands, + placed them.

- Slopes - He placed them all just right.

5. God's Preeminence (40:15-24)

↳ (First above all)

- 40:15 - Lit., "a drop from a bucket"

The small dust - as powder on the scales

40:25-31

1. He can do anything!
2. He knows everything!

And He cares about me!

40:31 - "wait upon the LORD" - build together toward the
LORD.
